Their line has gone out through all the earth, And their words to the end of the world.

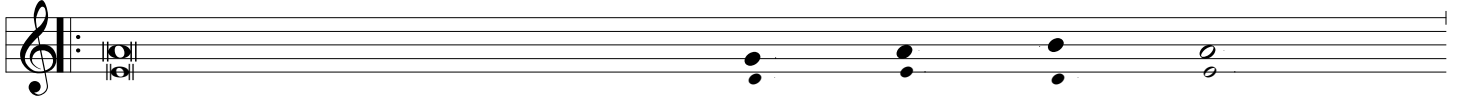
In them He has set a ta - ber - na - cle for the sun,

Which is like a bridegroom coming out of his cham - ber, And rejoices like a strong man to run its race.

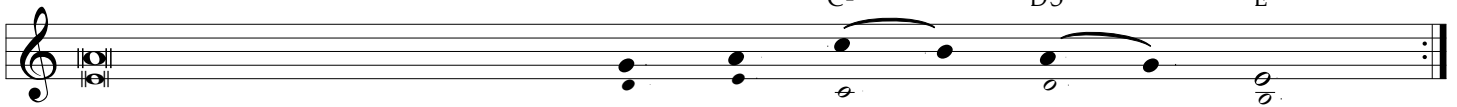
Its ris - ing is from one end of heav'n, And its cir - cuit to the oth - er end;

And there is no - thing hid - den from its heat.

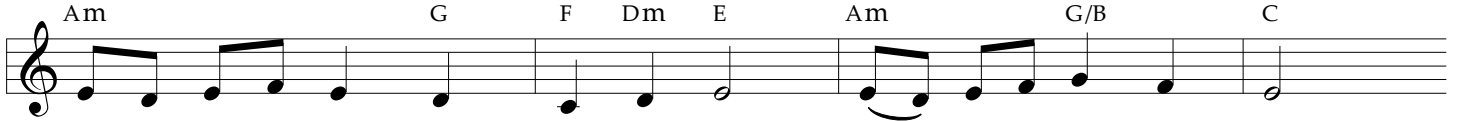

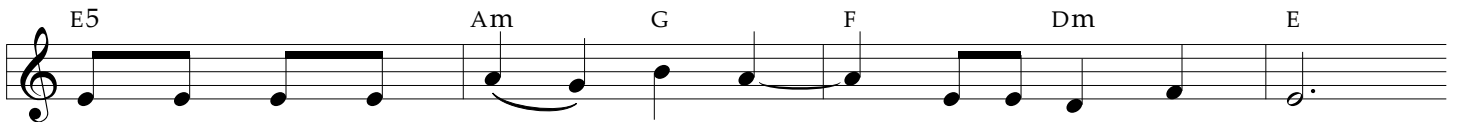
The law of the LORD is perfect, con - vert - ing the soul;

Sweet - er al - so than hon - ey and the hon - ey - comb.

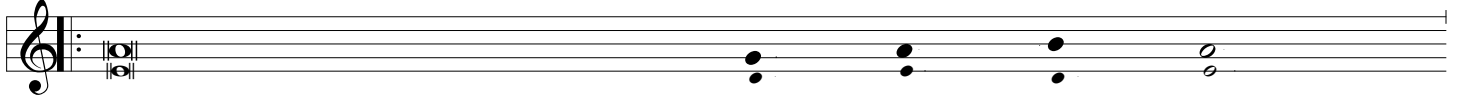

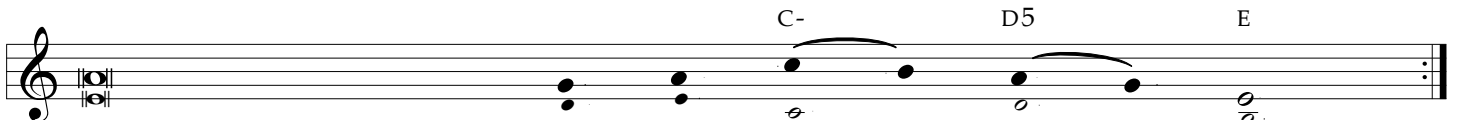

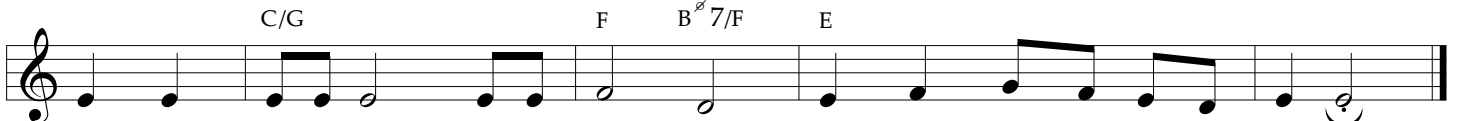
